## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 10-TM-02

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA; THAT**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 4 – Executive and Legislative Branch of Government, Sec. 3 – **Powers of the Tribal Council** – The Tribal Council shall exercise, in addition to all other powers lawfully granted to it, the powers listed in this Section; provided, that the exercise of such powers shall not conflict with Federal Law or terms of this Constitution: **Section 3(a)** - To negotiate, consult and contract with Federal, State, local and Tribal Governments, private enterprise, individuals and other organizations and **Section 3(k)** – To regulate all administrative and legislative bodies of the Tribe, Tribal agencies, officers and organizations; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Tribal Council finds it necessary to adopt this resolution so there is no conflict or contradiction in the Te-Moak Tribes decision or authority.

**THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribe's adoption of this resolution is to ensure the band councils shall not commit or speak on behalf of the Te-Moak Tribe.
